§1

the University of Szczecin shall direct, and the workplace shall accept, the following student

hereinafter referred to as the Company Practice Supervisor.

3. The Student's internship will be carried out in accordance with the Internship Programme
attached to this Agreement and agreed upon between the Company Internship Supervisor
and the Practice Supervisor.

§2

1. The workplace undertakes to provide the conditions necessary for the organization
and conduct of the apprenticeship, in particular:

- a) provide suitable workstations, premises, equipment, and materials, in accordance with
the internship program forming an integral part of this agreement,
- b) familiarize the student with the company's work regulations, health and safety
regulations, and other internal legal provisions if their knowledge is necessary for
the completion of the work placement,
- c) familiarizing the student with the regulations on the protection of the state, official
secrets, and other legally protected secrets if their knowledge is necessary for
the completion of the professional placement,

- d) provide the student with protective clothing, personal protective equipment, and sanitary measures for the duration of the internship, as provided by the regulations on health and safety at work,
- e) supervision of the student's performance of tasks resulting from the work placement program,
- f) provide the necessary data on the workplace necessary for the student to write the placement report, final project, or diploma thesis,
- g) certifying the course of the work placement (in an appropriate form submitted by the student), expressing an assessment of satisfaction with the placement, and drawing up an opinion on the student's work placement.

§3

1. University shall provide didactic and organizational supervision of the internship, in particular:
 - a) Appointment of a Practice Supervisor to oversee the didactic, educational, and organizational aspects of the internship,
 - b) establish an appropriate program for the internship, consistent with the student's field of study, in consultation with the Company Internship Supervisor,
 - c) carry out a satisfaction assessment of the work placement, both the student and of the workplace.
2. In relation to the existing system of voluntary insurance for student accidents, the University does not guarantee the existence of insurance cover for the student during the period of professional practice in the Workplace.

§4

1. The student is obliged to complete the internship in accordance with the program of the internship and in accordance with the rules of the company. This refers particularly to the principles of occupational safety and health, fire-fighting, working time, order, and discipline, as well as keeping official secrets and protecting personal data.
2. Students who grossly violate the rules of the internship may be expelled from the internship by the Company. The Department of Labour shall immediately notify the University of this fact. (Practice Supervisor; § 1, point 2 of the Agreement).

§5

1. Any modification of this Agreement shall be in a written form, otherwise being null and void.
2. In matters not regulated by the Agreement, relevant provisions of commonly applicable law, including the provisions of the Civil Code, shall apply.
3. Any disputes that may arise in connection with the implementation of this Agreement will be resolved, in the first instance, by mutual agreement and settlement; in the second instance, by a common court of competent jurisdiction in Szczecin.
